Hall of Fame Outstanding Alumni/Community Member Award

This prestigious award is given to outstanding graduates, faculty and staff members, or community members who have gone above and beyond in their contributions to the students of Anaheim High. Recipients of the Hall of Fame award are exemplars of exceptional accomplishments and, thereby, set high standards for Anaheim High School students.

Plaques honoring awardees will be permanently displayed on the AHS Hall of Fame Wall. In addition, the inductees will be honored at a dinner and during a half-time ceremony at a varsity football game.

Nominations will be accepted and considered by the Hall of Fame committee annually. To preserve the significance of this award, each recipient must be extremely deserving; therefore, even though nominees will be considered annually, there may not necessarily be a recipient every year. Numbers of recipients per year will be limited to 6, including one posthumous award if the Committee chooses. Nominators of candidates who were not selected may renew the nominations in consecutive years; self nomination is acceptable. Nomination may also be made posthumously. The nomination form must be signed by the nominee, but the nominee's name will be kept confidential if requested.
