The AHSAA Spirit Award is a \$1,000 scholarship that will be presented annually to a senior student who displays a well-rounded background in academics, extra-curricular activities and pride in being a Colonist. Candidates must plan to continue education in college or a vocational program at any accredited institution.

Completed application, two letters of recommendation and a biographical sketch that includes goals, interests, activities and accomplishments must be submitted by **April 1, 2011**. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. The AHSAA Scholarship Committee will review all applications, then invite candidates to a panel-style interview (see reverse). The scholarship winner will be selected by May 15, 2011, with notification shortly thereafter.

The biographical sketch should include goals, interests, activities and accomplishments, including academics, athletics, community services, hobbies, etc. The letters of recommendation may be from a teacher and/or employers.
